Summer Term

Staffing

It is a good opportunity to visit your current class and teacher and then move on to the next one. If you have something specific to discuss with a teacher, we would ask that you make an appointment for another time as Open Evening is not the right time to have a meeting.

PAWS need help with the summer fair. PAWS are short of adults which means that we might not be able to run an event similar to previous years. On average, the funds raised for the school at a Summer Fair is over £1000. This makes an enormous difference to the additional opportunities that the children have whilst in school. For example, in the past, PAWS money has brought the permanent outdoor play equipment and the stage and lighting for school performances totalling around £12,000!
