

Literacy

As readers we will be sharing 'The Knight and the Dragon'. As writers we will write our own fictional piece of writing based on 'The Knight and the Dragon'. As Historians we will be learning about the features of a castle, why castles were built, coats of arms, how to attack/defend a castle as well as designing our own castles!

When using computers
