

Maths



- To add and subtract two single digit numbers and count on or back to find the answer
- To recognise, describe and create patterns
- To solve problems including doubling, halving and sharing
- To use language about money, capacity and weight to compare different objects or quantities

Phonics



- To consolidate all Phase 2 and 3 phonemes
- To learn to read and spell words with adjacent consonants (Phase 4)
- To use phonic knowledge to decode regular words and read them aloud accurately

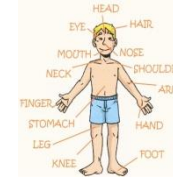
Literacy

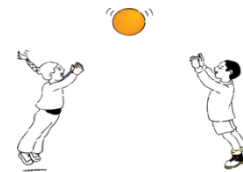


Expressive Arts & Design
