- 10<sup>th</sup> -11<sup>th</sup> September

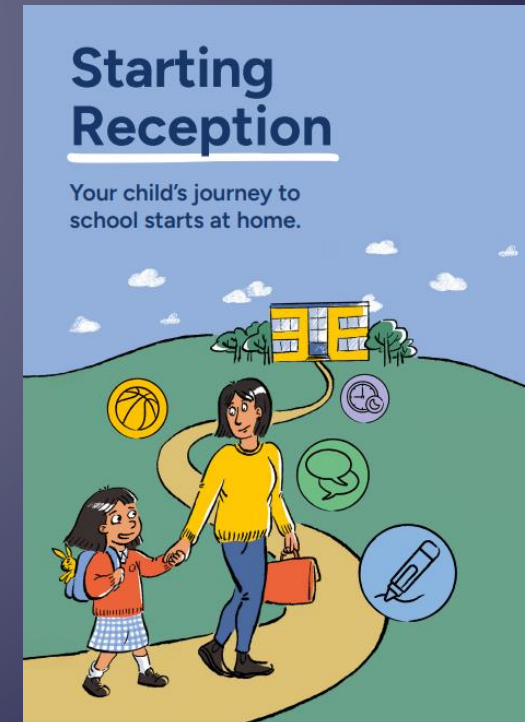
Children will stay for the morning session and lunch. Please collect your child from the classroom door at 1.15pm.
