- Sugar (500gram)

We kindly ask that the following are <u>NOT</u> included as donations:

- Food that is close to or past its expiry/best by/use by dates
- Breakfast cereals of any size (Foodbank already has a surplus of this item)
- Baked beans (Foodbank already has a surplus of this item)
- Tinned soups (Foodbank already has a surplus of this item)
- Tea bags (Foodbank already has a surplus of this item)
- Pasta (Foodbank already has a surplus of this item)
- Fresh, frozen or refrigerated foods
- Fizzy drinks
- Foods that require-additional ingredients to prepare (i.e., mixes for home preparation, bread mixes, etc.)
- Baking supplies
- Homemade food Items
- Condiments, Toppings, Chutneys, Relishes, Pickles, Olives, etc.
