Creating your own version of secondary school uniform

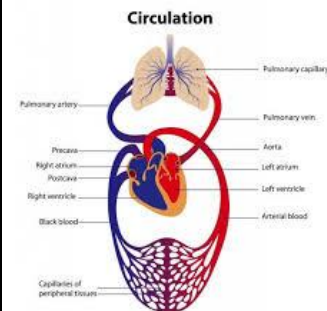
