Dear Parents and Carers,

As the Coronavirus epidemic continues, we are continually adapting our plans to cope with changes.

Due to the change in guidance earlier this week, which now requests that all household members follow self-isolation rules for a period of 14 days, even if only one person in the family shows symptoms, we have a number of children, families and staff who have made the decision to self-isolate. Due to the generic nature of the symptoms, which are similar to other viruses, we expect that this number may increase. The guidance also advised people with certain pre-existing medical conditions to socially distance. If they are able to do so, staff members are working from home. This **does not** mean we have a confirmed case of Coronavirus, only that the guidance has been followed as per the link below:
