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### **COVID - thank you!**

Thank you so much for continuing to be proactive regarding Covid. We will continue to send out letters if there is a positive case in your child's class or year group so that you can be aware. Thank you for your continued vigilance and support. In order to respond as soon as possible to any illness or absence from school due to Covid symptoms we have set up a [covid@wheatfields.cambs.sch.uk](mailto:covid@wheatfields.cambs.sch.uk) email address. Please use this email address to notify us of any Covid related absence and when you receive your negative test result and are able to email us the result. Should you or a member of your family receive a positive test result phone the school immediately. If it is the evening or weekend send an email using [covid@wheatfields.cambs.sch.uk](mailto:covid@wheatfields.cambs.sch.uk)

Guidance states that if another family member has tested positive for Covid and they need to self-isolate, other household members do not need to self-isolate and pupils can attend school **as long as they have no symptoms**. To help with stopping the spread from a household positive case, **daily LFD's** are suggested for any children aged 5 plus (recent age change). LFDs are free and can be ordered here <https://www.gov.uk/order-coronavirus-rapid-lateral-flow-tests>

You can also use this link <https://maps.test-and-trace.nhs.uk/> to find where you can collect LFT from locally. You need to enter your postcode and you may also need a code before collecting which you can get from a link on the page.

As you will be aware, testing capacity is pushed and as a result there is a suspension of the need to do a PCR if you have a positive LFD from **Tuesday 11th January**.

In addition, Gov.uk states that:

If you have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, **you have no symptoms** and you are:

- fully vaccinated or under 18 years and 6 months old, you should **do daily rapid tests** (1 a day for 7 days).
- not fully vaccinated, **get a PCR test** to check if you have COVID-19 on GOV.UK

**Anyone who has Covid symptoms must still get a PCR.**

This guidance also applies if you have tested positive within the last 90 days.
