

# EYFS BUSY CHOOSING ACTIVITIES

Collect some grass, petals, sand etc. from a garden or local wild space. Create a magical recipe for your potion <b>(THIS IS A MESSY ACTIVITY)</b>	List writing! Write a list of things you like, things that make you happy, your favourite toys or create your own list of items.	Use numbers to ten to create an exercise sequence for example Ten start jumps, nine spotty dogs, eight hops etc.	Draw a map of your street and highlight interesting things such as parks or bus stops.	Recreate a familiar story using props you can find in the house. <i>Ideas – we're going on a bear hunt, jack and the beanstalk, little red riding hood</i>	Mix cornflour and water together to create gloop and explore the different consistencies. <b>(THIS IS A MESSY ACTIVITY)</b>	Use teddies, animals or other toys to set up pretend school! Teach your animals the tricky words, digraphs or teen numbers	Can you create a story bag? Collect items in a bag that link to a known story or create one using the items. For more challenge write your story afterwards
Be helpful at home. Could you do a DIY job or help fix something?	Make some playdough with a grown up.	Have a board game or puzzle marathon!	Write a sentence a day diary about what you have done that day.	Keep moving! Play some music and make up a dance routine.	Use water and a brush to paint letters on the pavement outside your house.
