Our topic this term will be exploring people who help us. This topic is a chance for the children to consider people within their local community who help keep them safe, help others within their community and also those who help them on a day to day basis. This covers a wide variety of jobs such as postal worker, ambulance driver, teacher, nurse etc.

In 'normal circumstances' we would usually invite members of the local community into school to share their experiences with us. If you work in a job such as a paramedic, vet, police officer or fire fighter and would feel comfortable sharing your job role with us or answering a few questions via Zoom please do let us know.

As part of this topic we would like the children to create a representation of someone they see as special to them and their community or someone who helps them keep safe. This could be;

- A 3D model e.g. Lego fire truck or junk model post van
- A poster
- A PowerPoint or short animation film
- A picture or painting
- A show and tell e.g. modelling how to take care of a pet like a vet
- A story about a local 'hero'

You can send this project in whenever it is completed, **but no later than Friday 4th February**, to be shared in the final week of the half term.
