COVID - thank you!

Thank you so much for continuing to be proactive regarding Covid. Last week there were 1600 positive cases in schools across Cambridgeshire and Peterborough. We are monitoring our situation daily. There is no requirement to do so but we will continue to send out letters if there is a positive case in your child's class or year group so that you can be aware. Thank you for your continued vigilance and support.

In order to respond as soon as possible to any illness or absence from school due to Covid symptoms we have set up a covid@wheatfields.cambs.sch.uk email address. Please use this email address to notify us of any Covid related absence and when you receive your negative test result and are able to email us the result. Should you or a member of your family receive a positive test result phone the school immediately. If it is the evening or weekend send an email using covid@wheatfields.cambs.sch.uk

Self-isolation

If your child has any symptoms of Covid, a high temperature, a continuous cough or a lack of taste and smell, they must have a PCR test and self-isolate. **LFD tests are not suitable for symptomatic children aged 11 and under and will not be accepted by the school.** Guidance now states that if another family member has tested positive for Covid and they need to self-isolate, other household members do not need to self-isolate and pupils can attend school **as long as they have no symptoms**.

It is with sadness that we need to inform you that there cannot be any large gatherings of people in the school as we head towards Christmas due to the increasing numbers of cases in school sin Cambridgeshire. This affects all the school events on our calendar for this half term. We are being creative and coming up with ideas, so that the children don't miss out.

Christmas Performances – filmed and shared with parents

Trips and visits – can go ahead and are risk assessed on an individual basis



Pinpoint - for parents by parents



Pinpoint provide help and information to parents and carers of children and young people aged 0-25 with additional needs and disabilities in Cambridgeshire.

They offer signposting and events for all things SEND and are the Parent Carer Forum for Cambridgeshire. Pinpoint also give parent carers opportunities to have a say and get involved in improving local services.

No formal diagnosis is required to access support from Pinpoint – a child may be on a waiting list, accessing services, had a referral turned down, or just be struggling.

Pinpoint understand the value of peer-to-peer support and hold weekly virtual coffee mornings called 'Tii Hubs' during term times where parents/carers will always find a friendly face to chat to and can meet others in similar situations.

Pinpoint also hold professionally-supported workshops and events including sessions around autism, ADHD, sleep, anxiety and mental health. Full listings of our upcoming FREE virtual sessions can be found here.
