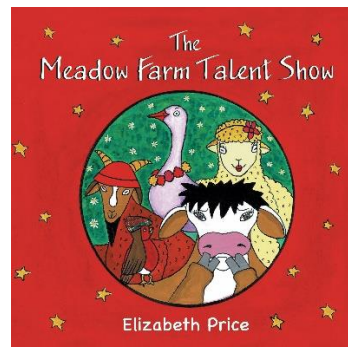
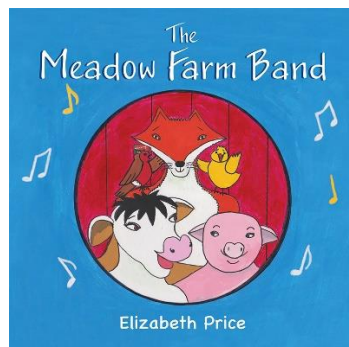
It has been a great pleasure to visit Wheatfields Primary today as an author/illustrator of children's books.
