Learning is exciting at Wheatfields Primary!

Reception This week EYFS have done us all so proud with their sparkling and shiny performances. We are so proud of them for their singing and dancing and changing; they have all been absolute stars. We have also been thinking about the story of Christmas and using our existing number knowledge to problem solve linked to the theme of Christmas.

Year 1 Year 1 have had a really busy week with 'Wriggly Nativity'. Thank you for all your support with the production. The children looked amazing in their costumes and they really enjoyed singing and dancing. Hopefully you are now in the Christmas spirit! We have been doing science this week and recording the weather to see how it changes, we have also been looking at how trees change over the year by using our art skills. Next week we will be exploring letters in English and looking at problem solving in maths.

Year 2 This week in Year 2, we have really enjoyed acting, singing and performing in our Christmas production 'Wriggly Nativity'. We had lots of fun in the dances and we hope that you enjoyed our performances if you were able to attend. In English, we have been reading the story of Rapunzel and we have been thinking about improving and extending our writing into paragraphs; we have been trying to include capital letters, full stops, question marks, conjunctions, similes and adjectives. So much to remember! Next week, we will be exploring the different elements that go into a fairy story and some of us will be creating our own. In our topic, we have been learning about food and banquets in castles, comparing them to the sort of food that we eat now. Next week we will have a 'castles day' to celebrate our new learning and we will share a banquet. In Maths, we have been learning how to add two-digit numbers together by drawing tens and ones to show our working out. Next week we will be continuing to practise this and will start to look at subtracting two-digit number too.

Year 3 Thank you to everyone for getting our Christmas costumes ready this week. We're going to be looking marvellous! We can't wait. This week we've been putting the world to right by holding our own General Election! Thankfully the children did a great job and our future should be safe in their hands! New political parties were created, manifestos written, spending priorities discussed, compromises made and a winner was declared. How refreshing it was to see issues such as clean water, nature, kindness and caring being made a priority, with not one mention of the 'B' word! Next week we're looking forward to the Christmas production, along with assessments and a super secret mission!
