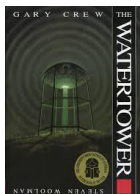


As a writer we will be...

Working with decimals, including ensuring an understanding of place value.

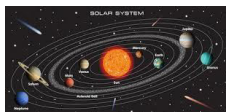
Consolidating knowledge of the properties of 2D and 3D shapes, plotting coordinates and reflecting and translating shapes.
