Story box

Use items around your house to create a story box.

You could decorate a shoebox to set the scene. Use the items to make up new stories. You could also write them down?

How many different stories can you create and share with your family?



Set up shop

Find some items in your house to use in your pretend shop. Write up price tags and make signs to help the customers.

To start with use 1p, 2p, 5p and 10p coins. Who will come to your shop? Can you work out how much they need? You could also sell your items to your teddies and help them work out what money they will need.



Outdoor scavenger hunt!

Go on a walk or explore your garden and find 10 interesting objects. Describe them to someone in your family and why you chose them.

Choose a few or all of your items and hide them in the house or garden.

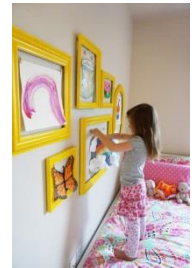


Write clues to your family about how to find them.

You could take pictures and send them to other family members and make it a virtual gallery!
