- Please get permission from your parent or guardian before taking part
- Your story should be a maximum of 500 words long
- Your story should be original and all your own work

- Please state your name and school year with your entry
- **Deadline for entries is 5pm on Friday 12th March 2021**
- Entries will be judged by a panel
