

Literacy

As readers we will be sharing "The Owl who was afraid of the dark" by Jill Tomlinson, "The owl and the pussycat" by Edward Lear and "Finding Winnie" by Lindsay Mattick and Sophie Blackall

As writers we will write our own chapters, descriptions of characters and settings and other fiction based passages

As Scientists we will be exploring animals, their structure and habitats

As Geographers we will be investigating seasonal changes and their effect on environments

As Artists we will be learning sketching techniques, using sketching pencils and exploring sculpture techniques creating an animal with clay

As Designers (DT) - We will be designing and creating a habitat for an animal

As Musicians we will be learning about pulse and rhythm and how to best use our bodies when singing

As Athletes we will be continuing to learn basic movements, balances and sequences to become gymnasts as well as developing our coordination, agility and balance. We will also be exploring using a racket and ball.

In PSHE we will be talking about our environment as well as continue our discussions exploring friendships and feelings.

In Computing we will be looking at developing our basic computer skills and learn how to be safe and respectful when using technology

Maths

As Mathematicians we will be looking at number and place value and using these skills to help us solve problems through investigations. We will also be looking at money and how we can use the skills learnt to help us again build on our place value skills. Year 1 will also be looking at counting up in 2s, 5s and 10s!

Phonics

As readers we will be sharing many books relating to our Storytime Phonics phonemes, digraphs and trigraphs and will be particularly focusing on alternative spellings of some digraphs. We will also be practising our real and Beegu words in preparation for our Phonics screening.
