<p>Can you make a skeleton? Later this term we will be leaning about bones and the skeleton.</p> <p>Your first choice is to make a human skeleton. You should name as many bones as you can and include interesting facts about it too.</p> <p>Challenge: can you make a skeleton that moves?</p>	<p>We know lots about the Romans from things that were found buried at Pompeii. We want you to imagine that you have dug up a Roman artefact. What have you found?</p> <p>Can you make it and tell us about it? What was it used for? Who would've used it? You can make it out of whatever you choose.</p>	<p>The Romans had their own way of writing numbers. We call them Roman numerals. Create a poster about Roman numerals. Write all of the different ones and say what they represent.</p> <p>You could also make up your own addition and subtraction questions for people using Roman numerals.</p>
