25 February 2021 – AS SENT OUT ON SCHOOLCOMMS TO KIDS CLUB MEMBERS:

Dear Parents/Carers

We are now happy to announce that we are able to re-open Kids Club again for morning and afternoon sessions from Monday 8 March 2021 for current Kid Club members and the usual charges will apply (as stated on the booking form attached).

However, government guidance via the DfE states that wraparound childcare can resume "where this provision is necessary to support parents to work, attend education and access medical care". **This means that we can only take bookings for your child(ren) if you meet this criteria.**

In addition to this please note:

- Numbers will be limited to 32 children at any one time
- Children can mix from different year group bubbles as long as the Kids Club bubble remains consistent (this means the bookings must be regular and not one-off sessions)
- Kids Club will close at 5pm on Fridays to allow for additional cleaning
- Spaces will be allocated on a strict FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED basis

If you meet the above criteria and wish to book sessions at Kids Club, then **please complete and return the attached booking form by 9AM ON MONDAY 1 MARCH 2021. We would prefer that you email your forms back to us, but if absolutely necessary then please drop them into School Reception by the deadline. Please wear a face mask when visiting school, thank you.**

This will only be possible if all of the plans are met under the Government's road map out of lockdown and further information will follow as and when we receive this.
