COVID vaccinations – please book!

Vaccination offer expands to all children aged 5-11

Parents who would like to have their child receive the vaccination are able to book vaccination appointments online via www.nhs.uk/covidvaccine. Children who are not in an at-risk group will need to wait 12 weeks between their first and second dose.



















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Children who recently had COVID-19 will need to wait to have the vaccination for 12 weeks after their symptoms started, or 12 weeks after the day of their positive test if they were not symptomatic.
