To help my child at school, I understand that:

I am responsible for checking the fitness of my child to attend School;

If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school and will follow isolation procedures;

If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school or makes the School aware of a household member who is, I will collect them from school immediately and follow isolation procedures;

When dropping off and collecting my child, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules and only use the designated gates/doors and times for my child's bubble;

My child will not bring any items into school with them or take items home from school (coat, water bottle, packed lunch are permitted and will be wiped down);

I will remind my child about social distancing rules but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child may not always do this successfully;

I will ensure my child wears clean uniform every day and that they have washed between each school day;

I will not be allowed into the school without a pre-arranged appointment and understand that Reception is only open for urgent enquiries;

I will read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home;

I will inform the school immediately of any changes to parent/carers and emergency contacts details;

I understand that if my child is deemed unsafe, he/she will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe;

I will do my best to:

Adhere to the social distancing rules in class and on the playground;

Tell an adult if I feel unwell;

Travel to and from school with an adult every day and not on my own or with friends;

Not bring things into school from home, or take things home from school;

Not mix with children from other bubbles in the school;

Only enter and exit the school building from the designated gates and doorways;

Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (catch it-bin it-kill it!);

Follow good hand hygiene – use soap and water for 20 seconds/ hand sanitiser;

Always behave well to maintain the safety of myself and others;

Follow these expectations and know that if I don't, I will be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe;

Understand that these changes are about keeping everyone safe, including me.

This 'Home-School Agreement' has been created with our pupils, staff, families and wider community at its heart. If, at any point, your child becomes distressed at the situation around them and their own well-being or mental health appear to be affected, then please do drop us an email or call and we will listen.

This will be a difficult transition but will enable our now virtual community to slowly begin re-connecting in person.



Thank you for taking the time to read this. As per our policies during this time, we will not be sending hard copies home, but your child will keep a copy in their learning folders at school.
