Make a representation of this.</p>	<p>Start a bean or plant diary.</p> <p>Write what you did to start with and then add updates as and when you see them!</p>	<p>Go on a GIANT hunt!</p> <p>Using the natural environment role play looking for giants!</p>	<p>Design lots of different magical beans using different medias and materials you may have e.g. paints, crayons, sequins, felt etc.</p>	<p>Use beans (or cubes/counters)</p> <p>To create simple addition and subtraction sums.</p>	<p>Jack and the GIANT PE!</p> <p>Practise taking long strides and jumps or practise your sprinting away from a giant!</p>	<p>Watch the story of Jasper's Beanstalk – this version has questions to answer at the end.</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Da6lxY_8jmU</p> <p>Talk about and order the days of the week.</p>	<p>Use natural items such as dried beans, lentils, sticks and stones to create a picture or collage.</p>
<p>GET BUILDING!</p> <p>Set building challenges to complete e.g. Make something using only one colour, a set amount of bricks or a timed race with a sibling or family member.</p>	<p>GET COOKING!</p> <p>Have a go at creating some Jack and the beanstalk inspired food! Cheesy beanstalk straws? Giant cupcakes?</p>	<p>GET ACTIVE</p> <p>BBC let's move has lots of fun programmes on lots of themes – space, animals, traditional stories etc.</p>	<p>GET SKETCHY!</p> <p>Pack up some paper and pencils and find a new spot to sketch.</p> <p>You could go for a walk along the river and stop to sketch.</p>	<p>GET CRAFTY</p> <p>Make a hanging beanstalk!</p> <p>Colour or paint a paper plate and then cut it into a spiral to make a hanging beanstalk. You could also add leaves and cotton wool clouds.</p>	<p>GET CREATIVE</p> <p>Design a giant!</p> <p>What would your giant look like?</p> <p>Design a giant and add labels e.g. hairy toes , big feet</p>	<p>GET MESSY</p> <p>Make some cloud dough using corn flour and baby lotion / conditioner. Experiment with a little of each until you get a smooth, cloud like dough! Add food colouring or paint to colour.</p>	<p>ACTS OF KINDNESS</p> <p>Be helpful at home. Could help Hoover or polish when tidying up.</p>
