Morning Whistle

From EYFS onwards, your children are encouraged to develop independence. When the morning whistle goes, we need parents / carers to say their goodbyes and then take a step back, away from the class lines. With the large volume of people in the playground during drop off, it is vital that all of the children know and can get to where they need to be without the help of a parent or carer.

If you need to speak to a member of staff first thing in the morning and it can be done quickly, teachers and learning support assistants are available but their priority is to make sure all of the children are ready to start their day and go into school. Sharing information that may take longer should be written and handed to the class teacher or emailed via the school office or please make an appointment via the admin team.

The 4 R's

This year at Wheatfields is all about the 4R's. This is in addition to our golden rules that we use to help us to be the best we can be. The 4R's are Resilience, Resourcefulness, Reflection and Reciprocity. It is hoped that recognition of and understanding of the 4R's will help the children to better understand themselves as learners, what sort of learner they are and how to be a better learner.
