

# EYFS BUSY CHOOSING ACTIVITIES

*Some of these activities are repeated from last week's grid as they can be revisited many times!*

Draw a treasure map and add labels. Write clues and see if anyone can find where x marks the spot!	Invent your own musical instrument using junk modelling. Perform a song to your family.	Go on a nature treasure hunt – look for natural treasures in the garden.	Get reading!  Read words, labels, stories...read every day and as many things as you can!	Write an update in your nature diary! What has the weather been like? What nature have you spotted?	Practise your ball skills- can you throw, roll, push a ball to a partner?
