Be a writer

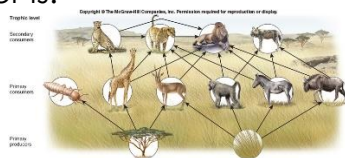
Create a fact file about a country in Africa. What is the name of the country? What are the houses, animals and weather like there?

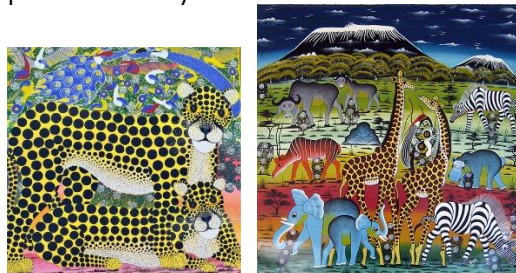
Be a scientist

What do African animals eat? Create a food chain. Find out what a predator is.



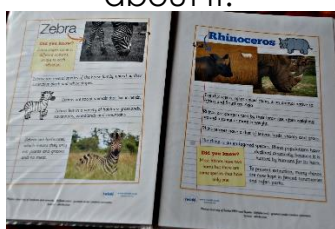
Get arty
